POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position Title: Evangelisation Leader

Location: Catholic Parishes of Doncaster and Templestowe

Employment Status: Contract – One year renewable (28 hr/wk., 50% Doncaster / 50% Templestowe) Hours can be negotiated to suit the applicant.

Reports to: Parish Priest

POSITION PURPOSE

The Evangelisation Leader is co-responsible with the Parish Priest and Parish Pastoral Councils for leading & implementing evangelisation as an additional facet of our parish life. This is the facet that grows us as a people who are excellent in being invitational (evangelising). The parishes have already been putting a lot of effort into excellence for our Worship and Social Outreach. Those facets will continue and grow but inviting people to come to know Jesus Christ requires a particular focus.

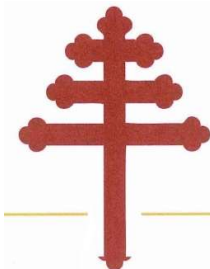
The Evangelisation Leader will help us to become, or become more, invitational. Explicitly bringing people to know Jesus by gently proclaiming the Good News. This role will help enhance the culture and capacity of the Catholic Parishes of Doncaster and Templestowe to become explicitly committed to evangelisation as well as other aspects of our mission to make disciples. Our parishes aspire to be filled with intentional disciples: bringing people to Christ and bringing the Gospel to the world. This role works in parallel with other roles in each parish that are accountable for the worship, outreach, financial and changing-church facets of a vibrant, vital and viable parish.

Critical to the position is a capable “missionary disciple”, knowledgeable and well connected to the guiding magisterial teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, including the New Evangelization and the teachings of Pope Francis on mission.

This role supports the Parish Priest and Parish Councils by identifying and addressing evangelisation needs. The role is expected to require the equivalent of four days (28 hours) of effort with the schedule of the hours worked determined by agreement but is expected to be spread across days and evenings including on weekends depending on what is actually required.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES (things the role is accountable for)

1) Evangelisation which advocates the implementation of Christ’s proclamation “Go, Therefore and Make Disciples of all nations (MT 28:19)” within the parish community, the inactive community, and the unchurched.

2) Evangelise through discipleship and catechesis of children, youth and adults incorporating new media and communication methods, and exploring new approaches to Christian Formation in order to form disciples who make disciples. This element must work in concert with youth/young adult efforts.

3) Discipleship and Worship: work with other groups in the parishes to develop and integrate evangelisation and intentional discipleship effectively into all the worship aspects of parish life.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES (things the role does, with the help of others)

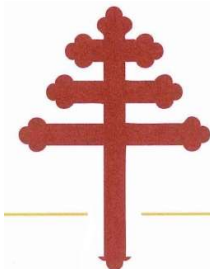
Evangelisation With the Parish Priest, Pastoral Council and Evangelisation Team

To establish an Evangelisation Team (volunteers/parishioners) and develop an effective overall parish evangelisation plan that draws on the work of others in the parish and integrates with the other four elements of a fruitful parish: Fellowship, Worship, Discipleship and Outward Focused Service. Alpha is listed first and will be a major focus initially but is not the only tool/focus that will be relevant over time.

- Leading and Coordinating Alpha and recruiting volunteers for:
 - Core Leadership Team
 - prayer team
 - catering and hospitality team
 - ensuring training of hosts and helpers (with Archdiocese and Alpha Australia)
 - establishing an effective leadership pipeline to grow leaders for other parish ministries
- Implement an invitational effort and attitude that can engage the active community, the inactive community and the unchurched in the parish region: to build relationships with and invite these individuals into our community more fully and ultimately into a relationship with Jesus. (Evangelii Gaudium)
- Monitors and adjusts the evangelization plan to reflect the parish's growth towards evangelization incorporating new learnings as needed and reviewing the plan annually.
- Collaborates with clergy, staff and volunteers (such as Liturgy, Music and Administration) to advance evangelizing goals in all facets of Parish life.
- Offers regular support, encouragement and presence to volunteers and promotes on-going evangelization opportunities for them.

Discipleship: With the Parish Priest, Pastoral Council and Evangelisation Team

- To develop an effective parish discipleship pathway which seeks to grow passionate intentional disciples into lifelong faith and relationship with Jesus, including developing groups such as Connect Groups, Bible Study etc. that follow on from Alpha / RCIA to provide support and companionship/friendship.
- With the existing youth / young adult groups and their leaders, help develop adult, young adult and youth small group ministry and culture at the parish, especially with a discipleship and evangelisation flavour.
- To explore new approaches to Christian formation that work in our culture in order to form disciples who then make disciples.

Other Responsibilities:

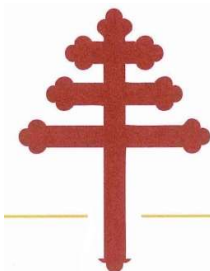
- Ensures Safeguarding requirements are fully / appropriately incorporated into all aspects of work.
